PBC currently has an articulation agreement with Eugene Bible College. We are in the process of establishing agreements with Corban College and Multnomah University. Southern Oregon University has reviewed our curriculum and has agreed to let transfer students from PBC transfer credits according to their standard transfer policy from non-accredited schools.
